Admission Requirements

- **G+PS Minimum Academic Requirements:** https://www.grad.ubc.ca/prospective-students/application-admission/check-your-eligibility
- **Program Specific Requirements:** A good academic standing of <u>at least 72% (B+)</u> final mark in the prerequisite courses
 - One Human Physiology course (e.g. <u>BIOL 155</u>, <u>BIOL 153</u>, CAPS 301)
 - One Introductory Biochemistry course (e.g. <u>BIOL 201</u>, BIOC 202)
 - One Statistics course (e.g. <u>STAT 200</u>, <u>LFS 252</u>, <u>BIOL 300</u>, EPSE 482, <u>FRST 231</u>)
 - One Introductory Nutrition course (e.g. <u>FNH 250</u>)
 - One Introductory Food Science course (e.g. <u>FNH 200</u>)

• Apply to BSFN (via you.ubc.ca), transfer credits, etc.

- Apply to the major (via Qualtrics)
- Referees receive forms from you or the website; fill out and submit to the Qualtrics link
- DDL: January 28, 2022 4pm PST
