Dietetics Equity Consultation Findings

- Funded by surplus in the budget
- Two consultants: one focused on policies, processes, admission documents, student surveys, background info on program, and another focused on "here and now" recommendations
- Provided with strength and weaknesses and 41 recommendations
- Organized into levels:
 - o Program
 - o Education
 - Advisory and stakeholder
 - Faculty (recommendations out of program's ability)
- After receiving the recommendations, program leads mapped recommendations on a spreadsheet by recommendation type beginning with more feasible or in progress recommendations followed by ones the program is unable to commit to due to human resources or time
- Need to delegate tasks, but need to hire staff to work on these tasks

Future Casting

- Prompt: What can we do to disrupt patterns
 - Suggested to have a presentation from dietetic at a townhall meeting to invoke action on the faculty-specific recommendations and how findings can be applied to other departments
- Traditional grading schemes and assessments
 - o Resource: "The Trouble with Rubrics"
 - How to get students to stop thinking about grades, and focus on learning instead
